### **Band Director's Report:**

Vending machine order was just made. Profit for the year should be 5,000.

Mrs. Runfola was very thankful to the boosters for all of their support with ticket collecting/sales, delicious meals for students and general help with their first performance in this venue. 710 Main was very accommodating and helpful with students and ticket collecting at the door. Next year we will pay upfront with our booster account and collect tickets thru the boosters funds. This will give the boosters more profit.
