Treasurer Report

Candy bars are sold out. We are unable to sell in school beginning January 2019. We will discuss a possible sign up for candy sales if students/families can sell outside of school in the future. We will discuss options for 2019/20 at a later meeting.

The Kleinhan's check to hold the hall has been sent.

A donation of \$150.00 from the Sneavly Family was accepted for the Jack Flick Memorial.

Our Booster taxes have been sent out.

We would like to purchase 2 new cash boxes and a new stamper "For Deposit Only".

<u>Chicken BBQ - Recap</u>

The Clarence High School Band Boosters are a 501 (c) (3) organization made up of parents who work to enrich the activities of the Clarence High School Band Program. We strive to enhance our children's musical experience at CHS and maintain the strong musical tradition in our town.

Our mission is to enhance the educational experience for ALL students. There were 77 dinners claimed by a few people who worked at the BBQ. Their child did not sell the tickets for these dinners. We don't fundraise/chair to boost our own child's account due to an upcoming trip.

Our goal should be a \$5,000.00 profit. We made \$3,063.00 profit. We had to refund 36 chicken BBQ dinners. We turned away 10 plus people who wanted chicken besides the

36 that were not available to ticket holders. 80 chickens weren't cooked and we had to pay a restocking fee at \$1.50 per chicken. Chicken dinners were given away to students who worked in the kitchen during the first shift. This is not what we do. A chairperson should have been there to oversee this. All dinners must be paid for.

Many things happened that could have been avoided if we were aware more help was needed. Communication is always key when we put on a fundraiser. There were children who worked who had already worked the Sub Sale. We should have had an accurate list of who needed to work the BBQ.

Suggestions for success in the future:

Have a copy of the letter sent home with students on the front table.

A new letter that goes home with tickets that is easier to read/understand for next year will be worked on.

Point person for help with student directions in the kitchen at all times.

Chair people must be at the BBQ the entire time. You are not able to deliver chicken dinners and oversee the sale at the same time.

Pre - Sale Dinners picked up by 6 pm.

Pre - Sale Tickets (\$10.00) should be a <u>different color</u> than those sold at the Door (\$12.00).

Have a list of students updated from the Sub Sale to let students know who must work the Chicken BBQ. The chairpeople should provide this to the Directors as they are busy teaching our children.

Possible date for next year: October 25, 2019. Fall back date: October 18, 2019. We will determine once the school calendar is approved in March or April. We want to avoid a Superintendent's Conference Day.
