Band Directors' Reports: Mr. Vitello/Mrs. Runfolo (not present)

Mr. Vitello shared information about the upcoming Boston trip. The 3rd payment is due on 2/15. There are 3 full buses with 55 on each bus. The rules of the trip were clear at the onset of the trip planning. If changes happen in Boston they have a bus reserved for additional students. Parent/child meeting for the trip on Monday, April 18, 7 pm.

Mr. Vitello shared Kleinhan's concert information. Students will not need to bring their proof of vaccine card. There will be a certified list from the school provided for Kleinhan's. Students who are unvaccinated will be able to Covid test the day of the dress rehearsal (at CHS) and this will be good for the concert day also. The auditoriums in the district are not large enough for a piece being performed this year. As of today, audience members need to be vaccinated. This could change by 5/27. Live stream of the concert will be available as well as a bus for return to CHS if parents do not attend.

Mr. Vitello also shared that Kleinhan's field trip should commence on March 4, after the other previous 2 have been canceled due to snow closings.

The wreath/poinsettia sale was very successful with over \$2,000 in sales and revenue for student accounts.

The Vending machine is going very well. The income is about \$2,250 after the cost of supplies. Using a credit card for BJ's for supplies is easier for purchasing.

We received a donation of \$240.00 from Zach Kneeland at Morgan Stanley. We should put his name in the program for Kleinhan's. We will send a thank you note and also ask him for an ad for the program as thanks.
