## Band Directors' Reports: Mr. Vitello/Mrs. Runfola

- Boston Trip Update final approval at 10/18, BOE meeting. Students must be vaccinated or have a negative covid test 72 hours prior to departure. Motor coach and hotel are secured. Trip insurance is mandatory (\$32-34 approx.). Trip must be canceled 48 hours prior to departure to be refunded 75% of the cost of the trip. Students will room in double/triple or quad per family choice. Students will be in pods and seated together on coaches, dining, concerts, etc. This is not a mandatory trip. It is not a performance trip, it is a cultural trip. A school nurse will be on the trip and will take care of anything covid related. If a student is ill they will be quarantined and family will need to come pick them up. There will be a rules/regulations form for each family to sign and have notarized. Trip itinerary will be completed once the trip has approval of BOE. Some places to visit will be the New England Conservatory of Music for a concert and master class, Boston Symphony Concert, Art Gallery, Harbor Cruise, Duck Tour, etc. Chaperones will be school teachers and band boosters only. NYC is not an option due to safety concerns right now.
- Conference All State participation is BOE approved as it is similar to a state championship.
